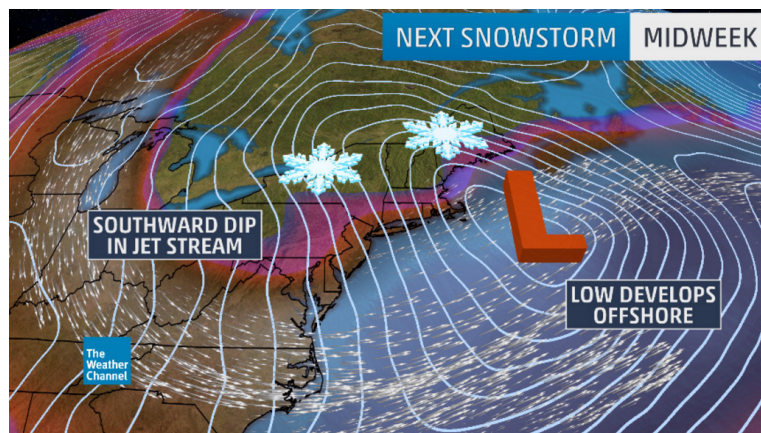


## Why You Need a Mt Weather Forecasting Course & What you'll Learn
