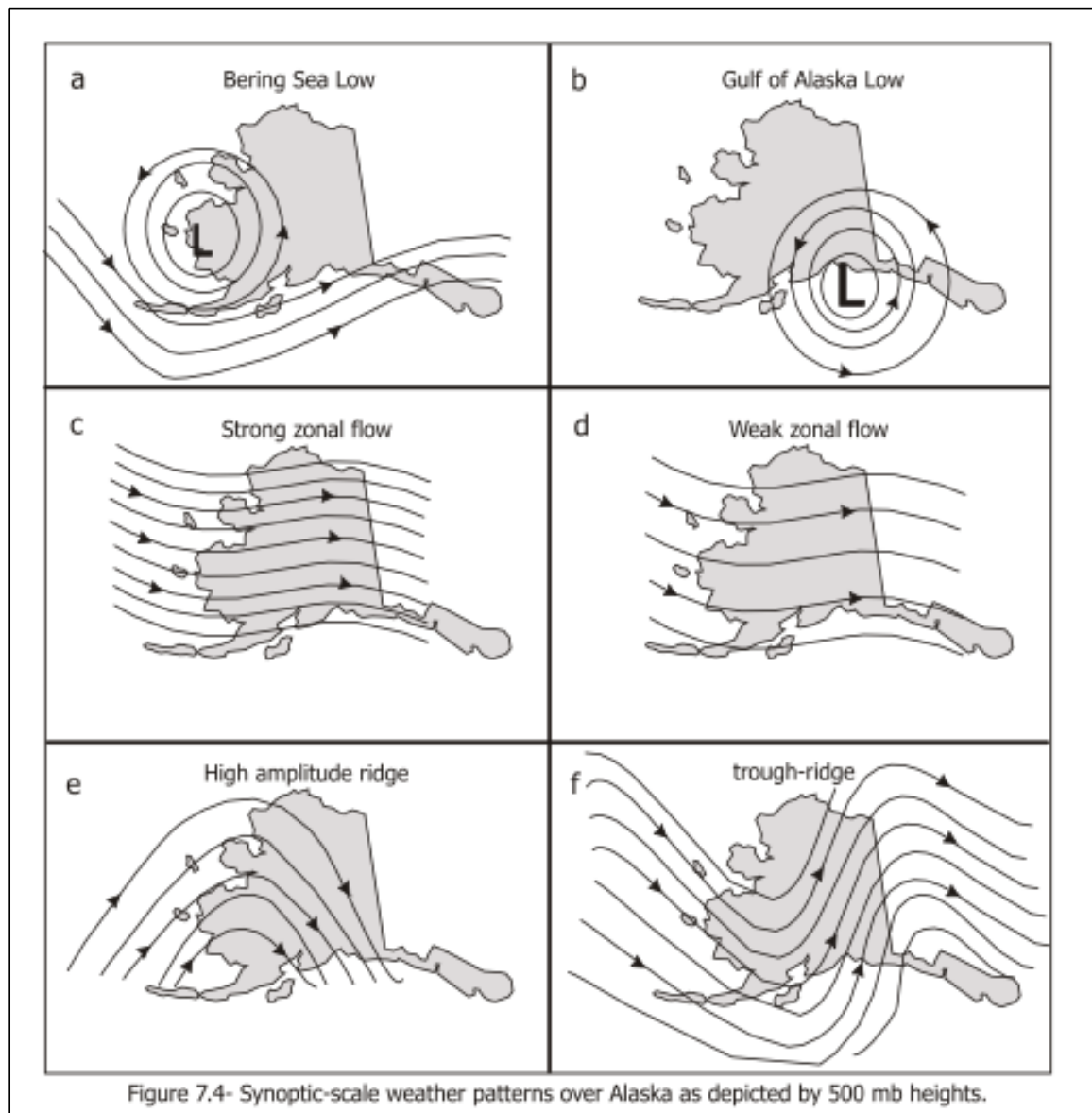


Alaska Weather Patterns



- Aleutian Low – Low pressure center that resides out by Aleutians. This is where most big, wet, storms originate in Winter (October to April).
- Storms that originate from the East are generally drier, less frequent, & less energetic.
